### OBJECTIVE

### TOOLS

### TODAY'S LESSON

4:00 - 4:05	Attendance & Check-in <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>★ Question of the day: Name, how are you feeling, what kind of animal are you today?</li></ul>
4:05 - 4:15	Warm Up <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>★ Number game<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Students will be asked to count to 10 by each saying a number one at a time. If two students speak at the same time, we will have to re-start. If successful, we will try for 15.</li></ul></li></ul>
4:15 - 4:25	The Lesson <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>★ We will start talking about what the key aspect of improv is, which is the concept of “yes, and...”</li><li>★ Has anyone seen an improv show or done improv? What did you notice?</li></ul>
4:25 - 4:40	The Activity <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>★ Story in the round<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Students will be given 1 minute to tell a piece of a story according to a provided order. This will last for about 5 minutes.</li></ul></li><li>★ What are you doing?<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Students will perform an action like brushing hair or eating. When asked “what are you doing?” they will say a completely different action that the next person will then take on.</li></ul></li><li>★ Panel of experts<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Three “experts” are appointed to answer questions based on a topic chosen by the audience.</li></ul></li></ul>
